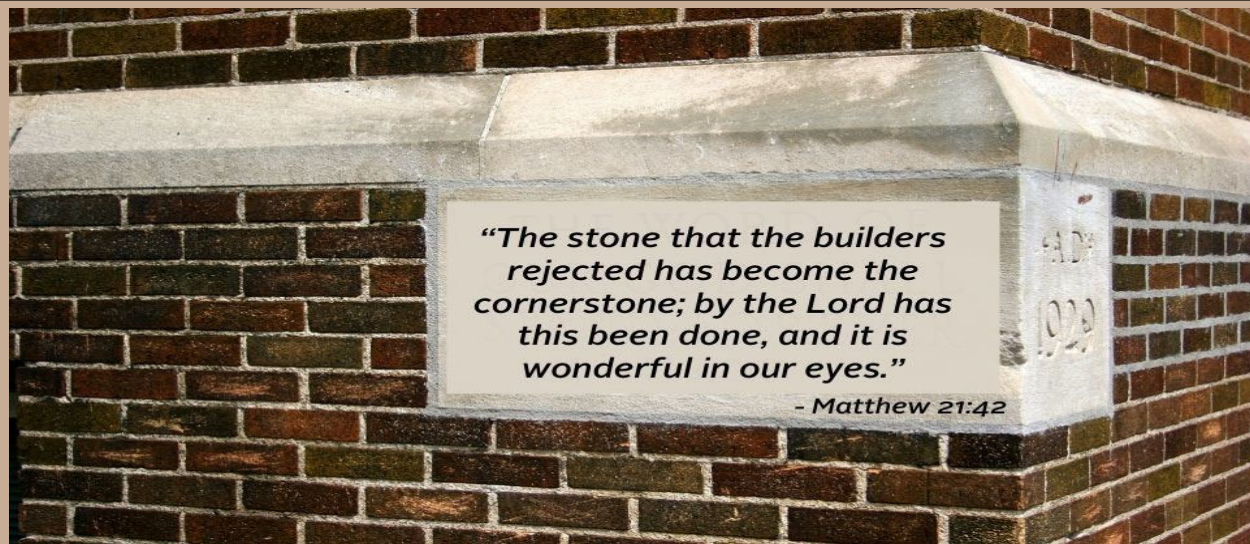

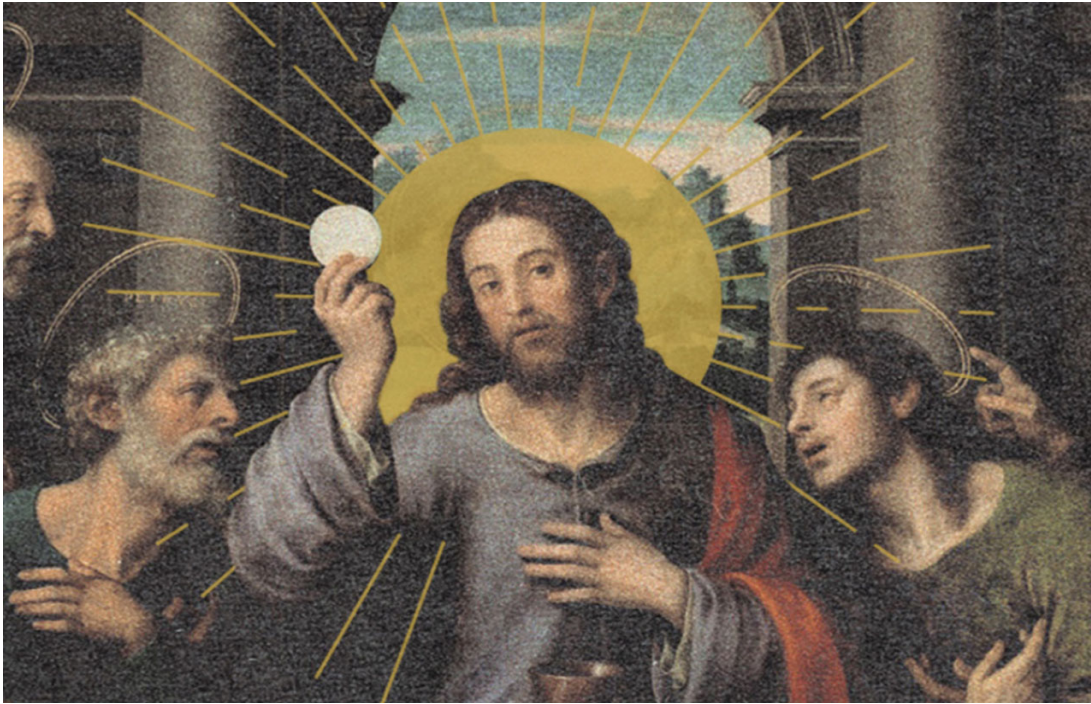


Parish Baby Shower—October is **Respect Life Month**. Last year we had a month long Parish Baby Shower to support the Marin
